4. LEARNING OBJECTIVES

1st Dublin descriptor – knowledge and understanding

At the end of the course, the student will be able to argue the meaning of the contents of the modules with particular reference to medical-scientific articles

- Written reports and oral presentations of the exercises and group work conducted and highlighting of further needs for further study to achieve the results described in points 4 and 5.
